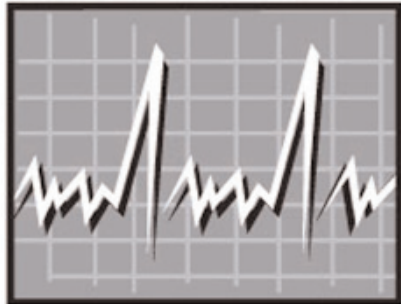

## Services Provided

### INDIVIDUAL THERAPY AND COUNSELING

Services consist of one-on-one sessions with a licensed therapist.

### SKILL DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Services and activities consist of aiding individuals in building their self esteem, character, decision making skills and communication skills.

### FAMILY COUNSELING

Activities and group sessions to aid in the clients success.

### LPHA ASSESSMENTS

Assessments utilized to authorize Remedial services.





### TRACKING AND MONITORING

Services to monitor the clients behaviors in the home and the community.

## REMEDIAL SERVICES

Any child that has or can receive Title 19 or Medicaid that can be diagnosed with a mental health disorder (ex. ADHD, ADD, Conduct Disorder, Bi-Polar) by an Licensed Practitioner of the Healing Arts (LPHA). Children receiving these services do not have to be involved in the Juvenile Court system or DHS involved. Remedial Services can be used as a preventive way to keep children in the home and out of Juvenile Court or DHS.

*Remedial Services are services that are skill based which include:*

-  Anger and/or behavior management
-  Relationship, communication, problem-solving and/or social skills
-  Conflict resolution
-  Skill rehearsal

*Remedial Services can be delivered to a client in the following ways:*

### INDIVIDUAL

Interventions used to modify the psychological, behavioral, emotional, cognitive, and social factors affecting the individuals functioning. Interventions designed to include the following skills for effective functioning with family, peers, and community (schools).

### FAMILY

Interventions used to enhance the family's ability to effectively interact with the child in such a way to support the individual's functioning in the home and community to assist in the management of psychological, behavioral, emotional, cognitive, and social factors affecting the individuals functioning. Interventions designed to include the following skills for effective functioning with family, peers, and community.

### CRISIS

Interventions provided as outlined in a written treatment plan to de-escalate situations in which a risk to self, others, or property exists (home, community, and school). Services assist the child to regain self-control and use age appropriate coping skills.

### GROUP

Interventions used to modify the psychological, behavioral, emotional, cognitive, and social factors affecting the individuals functioning by providing a group setting with other clients that display similar behavioral issues. Groups will focus on anger management, behavior management, relationship skills, communication skills, problem solving skills, conflict resolution, skill rehearsal, and social skills.

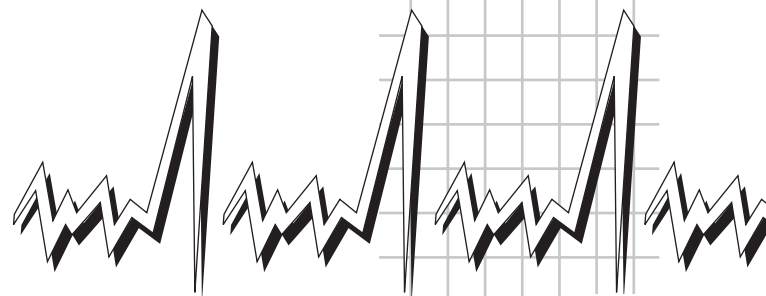
